

Translation of Ernst Gombrich's cv held at the University of Vienna by Karl Johns, Riverside, California

I, Ernst Gombrich, was born in Vienna on March 30, 1909 and live there. I attended the humanistisc Gymnasium of the Theresianum where I graduated Summer 1928. In October of the same year I entered the Philosophical Faculty of the University of Vienna and after completing the necessary requirements in paleography and diplomatics in March 1929, I became a regular member of the II. Kunsthistorisches Institut (Lehrkanzel Hofrat Schlosser). I attended lectures and seminars held by the professors and assistant professors Schlosser, Strzygowski, Swoboda, Baldass, Eisler, Ginhart, Glück, Hermann, Tietze in the history of art, Reisch, Eichler, Löwy, Praschniker, Schober in archaeology, Bühler, Reiningger, Schlick, Gomperz, Garbeis, Kainz, Rohretz, Wahle in philosophy as well as Professor Junke in Egyptology and Professor Ettmayer in philology.

I used the vacations for travel studies in Austria, Italy and Germany. I spent extended visits studying in Berlin, Rome and Mantua.
